

FELIX BAUDENBACHER FIFTEEN PIGS

For his installation 'Fifteen Pigs' Baudenbacher has taken on quite a job. Among others a strict information policy. We are curious to see the results!

Felix Baudenbacher's grandparents ran a pig farm in the 1950s and 1960s in the Canton of Thurgau – 'Fifteen Pigs' is a reference to it. There are certain restraints regarding the release of names, years of birth and domiciles.

No further information other than that will be released before the show 'Fifteen Pigs'. During the show the visitors will be invited to form their own opinion on the meaning and the content of the installation and the single works. Questions can be addressed at any time directly to the gallery staff or to the artist.

'Light/time, architectural space and plaster are the newest expressive elements I'm exploring in my search for moments of visual excitement and wonder, which, when the art is successful, trigger an involuntary, near-physical response that makes one want to look at the work again and again and again - enriched by the experience every time anew.'
